

## Application for sponsorship for Hydrogen short course 2024

### Terms and conditions

1. Sponsorship is available for 6 attendees (3 for each course).
2. All applicants must be enrolled at a HyDEX partner institute or C-DICE academic partner. Please see: <https://www.cdice.ac.uk/partnership/>
3. The course fee sponsorship is non-transferable, non-convertible to cash and non-redeemable for cash.
4. The sponsorship awarded is in the form of a course fee waiver. The sponsorship excludes all other charges or costs such as accommodation, travel, subsistence, etc. which shall be borne by the applicant.
5. A panel chaired by the HyDEX skills officer, and consisting of Cranfield course directors, and C-DICE Development Strand Project Manager will decide on the recipients of the sponsorship, and their decision will be final. There will be no appeals process.
6. The successful candidates will be notified by email and will need to apply for the course via Cranfield application process.
7. The recipients will be expected to complete the course in full and attend for the entire course duration.
8. On completion of the course, candidates are required to participate in the HyDEX Hydrogen Researcher Festival later in the year. This might include a poster submission, presentation or workshop design and delivery – to be agreed with the HyDEX skills officer. Information about the festival will be published on the HyDEX website and HyDEX social media (this includes any contributions from the candidates who receive this sponsorship).
9. If a recipient is no longer available to attend the course, they will need to inform the HyDEX skills team in writing at least 1 week prior to the start of the course.
