

Application for sponsorship for Hydrogen short course 2024

Terms and conditions

1. Sponsorship is for the course fee only, and is open to current UK research students, postdoctoral researchers and early career researchers.
2. Sponsorship is available for a limited number of places on the following short course at Cranfield University:
Hydrogen for civil aviation – H2 in the aircraft (18-22 November 2024)
3. Applications will be reviewed weekly. We reserve the right to close applications, once we have awarded the maximum number of course sponsorships.
4. All applicants must be enrolled or working at a UK higher education institute.
5. The course fee sponsorship is non-transferable, non-convertible to cash and non-redeemable for cash.
6. The sponsorship awarded is in the form of a course fee waiver. The sponsorship excludes all other charges or costs such as accommodation, travel, subsistence, etc. which shall be borne by the applicant.
7. A panel chaired by the HyDEX skills officer, and consisting of Cranfield course directors, will decide on the recipients of the sponsorship, and their decision will be final. There will be no appeals process.
8. The successful candidates will be notified by email and will need to apply for the course via Cranfield university application process.
9. The recipients will be expected to complete the course in full and attend for the entire course duration.
10. On completion of the course, we will ask recipients to write a reflective blog or post for LinkedIn describing their experience of the course. **Please note:** This will also be published on the HyDEX website and social media.
11. If a recipient is no longer available to attend the course, they will need to inform the HyDEX skills officer in writing prior to the start of the course (1 week notice if possible).
